Earlier BT phones came with NiCd Nickel Cadmium rechargeable batteries with lower capacities, these batteries have since been

replaced with the more environmentally friendly NiMH Nickel Metal Hydride rechargeable batteries which do not contain Cadmium. The added benefit of NiMH over NiCd is the capacity of the batteries being around double, giving you extra talk time and no physical change in the size of the battery. Think of the capacity as the amount of fuel the battery can hold. So, for example, if your old BT cordless telephone battery pack was a NiCd 3.6V 300mAh, its fine to replace this with the new NiMH 3.6V 600mAh battery pack. When a new battery is inserted in you BT phone for the first time, please refer to the instructions regarding its initial charging period this is usually something like 16 hours and is like a running in time for the new battery.
